SYNOPSIS

The Department of Botany, St. Joseph's Degree College, Kurnool, organized a **Career Counselling Session** on the topic "**Global Trends in Botany and Job Markets**" for III B.Sc. Botany students on 30 July 2026. The session was delivered by **Dr. Guneti Sri Ranganayakulu, Assistant Professor & Head, Department of Botany, Rayalaseema University, Kurnool.**

The resource person highlighted the importance of Botany in addressing global challenges such as biodiversity conservation, climate change, food security, environmental sustainability, and human health. He explained how Botanical Sciences play a crucial role in Agriculture, Forestry, Biotechnology, Pharmaceuticals, Ecological Restoration, And Conservation of Natural Resources. Students were encouraged to appreciate Botany not only as an academic discipline but also as a field that contributes significantly to sustainable development and the well-being of society.

Dr. Sri Ranganayakulu also emphasized the importance of ethics and moral values in scientific research and professional life. He encouraged students to uphold honesty, integrity, environmental responsibility, respect for biodiversity, and social commitment while pursuing their careers. The session stressed that a successful botanist should possess not only scientific knowledge but also a strong sense of ethical responsibility toward nature and society.

The speaker provided detailed information about the emerging career opportunities available to Botany graduates in India and abroad. He explained career pathways in Higher Education, Research Institutions, Biotechnology Companies, Pharmaceutical Industries, Seed Industries, Agriculture, Forestry, Environmental Consultancy, Wildlife Conservation, Horticulture, Plant Tissue Culture, Microbiology and Government Organizations such as the Botanical Survey of India, Forest Department, ICAR, CSIR, and State Biodiversity Boards. He also guided students on preparing for competitive examinations, pursuing postgraduate studies, research fellowships and developing employability skills required in the global job market.

The interactive session inspired students to broaden their career perspectives, strengthen their academic foundation and continuously upgrade their skills to meet international standards. 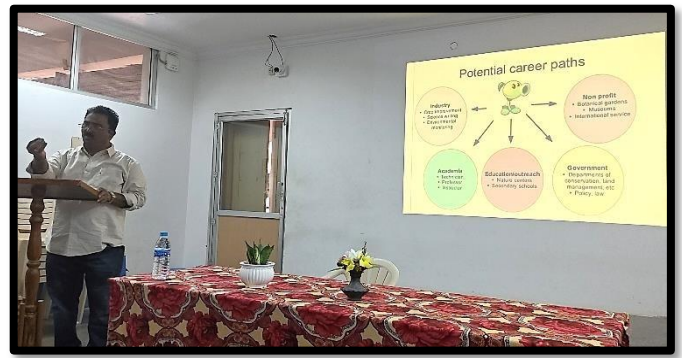
OBJECTIVES

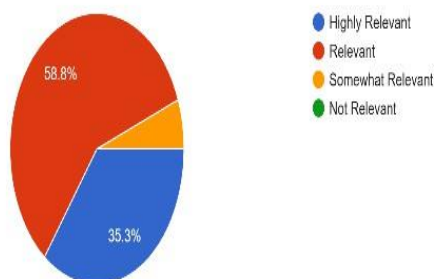

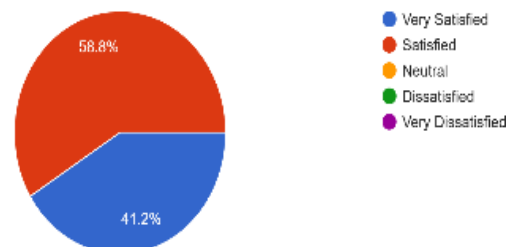
How relevant was the topic to your academic and career goals?
