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Life Cycle of a Mosquito

Eggs → Larva (Wiggler) → Pupa (Tumbler) → Adult Mosquito

Preventive Measures

- Remove stagnant water regularly.
- Keep surroundings clean and dry.
- Use mosquito nets and window screens.
- Wear full-sleeved clothes.
- Use natural repellents (neem, tulsi, citronella).
- Keep water containers tightly covered.
